



Total Exposure Description & Tips

Total Exposure is a titillatingly wild game that combines 4 card Poker with double exposure blackjack! Total Exposure has higher bonus pay outs than 4 card poker. In the blackjack portion of the game, the player has the advantage of seeing both of the dealers starting cards but the house wins ties. Players who play good basic strategy have a better chance in double exposure than in regular blackjack.

Rules for Total Exposure Blackjack

Total Exposure is double exposure blackjack with an optional bonus bet on the poker value of a 4 card stud hand consisting of the player's initial two cards and the dealer's initial two cards which are turned face up.

Total exposure can be played with 1, 2, 4, or 6 to 8 decks.

Total Exposure is like regular blackjack except:

- a) both dealer's cards are exposed;
- b) dealer wins ties except player's blackjack;
- c) blackjack pays 1 to 1.

Additional suggested house rules are:

- a) dealer hits soft 17;
- b) player may split only once;
- c) double after first 2 cards;
- d) double after splitting allowed;
- e) tied blackjack pays 1 to 1.

Approximate house edge .68%

4 Card Stud

An optional 4 Card Stud bonus bet is allowed.

The card room sets minimum and maximum bets.

Card room may choose either "Pair Push" or "Jacks or Better" pay scales.

A per table/player aggregate may be used in compliance with WSGC rules regarding aggregates.

Approved payout schedules are included below.

*Players who wager \$5 or more on the 4 Card Stud bonus are eligible for these envy pay outs on all other player hands at the table. **Players may not envy their own hands if they are playing more than one hand.**
